

Fruit 'n' Veg Week 2009 STUDENT COMPETITIONS

Kindergarten/Pre-Primary/Year 1

Task: Fruit and vegetable prints. Using cut up fruit and vegetables (good ones include carrots, star fruit, mushrooms, cauliflower, apples, broccoli and tomatoes), dip into paint and create a picture of a person or landscape. Send a photo or the original of the artwork to us.

The winning entry will have their artwork made into a personalised Australia Post stamp!



Conditions of entry

- Students must be in Kindergarten, Pre-primary or Year One and belong to a West Australian school.
- Schools may enter as many students as they wish.
- Colours are to be bold
- Student's name, year level and school must be clearly labelled on the back of their work.

The winning entry will receive sports equipment to the value of \$75, a Go For 2&5® prize pack and a page of postage stamps with their design printed onto it.

Years 2-4 and Years 5-7

Task: create a veggie boy or girl playing a favourite sport or physical game. The veggie boy or girl can be made from cut up fruit and vegetables and photographed, or drawn. Write 1-3 paragraphs on the topic "Get your skates on – how to get fruit and veg and physical activity into your day" to accompany the veggie character.

Conditions of entry

- Students must be in years 2 to 7 and belong to a West Australian school.
- Schools may enter as many students as they wish.
- Veggie characters can be drawn or constructed from fresh fruit and vegetables and then photographed
- Paragraphs can be typed or handwritten
- One winning entry will be selected from years 2 to 4 and one from years 5 to 7.
- Student's name, year level and school must be clearly labelled to the back of their work.



The winning entries (Years 2-4 and 5-7) will each receive a sports equipment pack to the value of \$100, and a Go For 2&5® prize pack.

All entries are to be received at Cancer Council WA **no later than Friday 25 September 2009.**
